Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome Back! SGC & Action Team Overview (Ross Bogatch/Stephen Colosi, Daiana Negron)

Bifurcation of Council business/membership from Action Team business/membership.

- 2. Media Center (Daiana Negron)
 - Media center not included as part of Specials
 - Technology Integration Support Specialist (TISS) replaced Media Specialist position in fall of 2020
 - Mr. Dean retired in spring of 2022, Nithiwadee Suparattananon
 - TISS position: 60% in tech support capacity, 40% teaching/library services.
 - Daiana proposed interns running library services interns would be SPS high school students
 - Teachers are more than welcome to bring students to the media center to check-out books.
- 3. Tablet Distribution Program (Dr. Bonasera, Paula Gadtaula)

- Ms. Gadtaula described a national program through the FCC for distributing tablet computers and wifi to families
- Maxsip Telecom manufactures the tablets, five years of free internet
- Families contribute government mandated copay (\$20 for Ms. Gadtuala's program; \$8-\$50 is the Federal requirement), \$15 goes back to organization
- AT&T is internet provider
- Mark Bonasera will speak with district staff members about the program
- 4. SGC Elections (Ross Bogatch/ Stephen Colosi, Dr. Bonasera) Will hold elections for one parent member and two teacher members in October
- 5. Administrative Team Update (Dr. Bonasera)
 - Safety September 23 Safety meeting. Introduced the new security guard, Christopher Garner. Access to all security cameras. Reviewed safety protocols, RAPTOR program, new doors through the building, pickup and dropoff.
 - Academics: focus on Tier I, small-group instruction and science of reading
 - Intervention: following Scientific Research Based Intervention process (SRBI) to determine whether students receive intervention services of any kind
 - Enrichment: submitted Extended School Hours grant application on 9/30
- 6. Action Team (Daiana Negron, Dr. Bonasera)
 - Read-a-loud: teamwork, poetry, facing fears, inspired by true story, problem solving
 - Held in fall and winter, online or in person
 - Guest readers from community
 - Include trivia questions about read aloud books, offer prizes to students for answering questions
