3. Brilliant Pathways (formerly College for Every Student) School.

Through implementation of the HOTS approach, we are providing students with exposure to visual, musical, and kinesthetic arts, infusing the arts into all academic areas, and fostering greater student engagement and voice. Positive Discipline is a program for both educators and parents that we implement to foster a positive school climate. Through the Brilliant Pathways program, students explore colleges, careers, and goals through mentoring, field trips, and career days.

Parents actively participate in school improvement through groups such as the Roxbury Organization of Parents and Educators, School Governance Council, Building One Community POWER Parents, and Hispanic Parents.

We work closely with community agencies to serve our students and families, such as Chester Addison, Boys & Girls Club/Yerwood Center, Building One Community, and many more.

Roxbury School staff members are caring, dedicated, strategic, and collaborative. We differentiate instruction to provide support and challenge to students, based on their needs and strengths. Staff members take part in ongoing professional development to share best practices and improve their teaching methods.

Our before- and after-school programs include: Science Scholars, InTempo Music, Sports and Recreation, Hip Hop Dance, African Drumming, Art of Gardening, Art Start, Yoga, Homework Helpers, and Reptiles. Grade 5 students attend Nature's Classroom in the fall. The ROSCCO program meets on site, before and after school.
